Theme nr.2 consists in presenting the List with the records with respect to the services offered by **2 libraries** (a university one and a public one) as well as a List with bibliographic data for **two secondary documents** within your interest field (render their bibliographic data, the UDC –Universal Decimal Classification index, the descriptors and the shelf mark).

The file will comprise:

- Doctoral student's name and first name
- Doctorate field
- Required lists.

**Notes:**

1. Secondary documents are usually, „books about books” – they analyze the primary documents and they are produced by experts in the information processing: librarians, bibliographers, documentarists, booksellers. Examples: Library catalogues, Publishing house catalogues and Bibliography of the doctoral theses etc.

2. Traditional catalogues (alphabetic, systematic, on subjects, geographic, topographic, chronologic) the widest spread are those in guise of cards on paper support (standard format is 12,5 x 7,5 cm).

3. Online catalogues (**OPAC – Online Public Access Catalogue**) are catalogues on informatics support, within a database, in which the users' access is carried out directly, through the intermediary of a terminal.
